URGE CONGRESS to Help Release Funds for International Education

The U.S. Office of Management and Budget's Director Russell Vought and the U.S. Department of Education's Secretary Linda McMahon have not released and allocated the \$85,664,000 provided in the FY 2025 Full-Year Continuing Resolution Act for the Higher Education Act-Title VI, and Fulbright-Hays 102(b)(6). These funds for the U.S. Department of Education's International Education and Foreign Language Studies account are crucial for our nation's security and global economic competitiveness.

APSA members are invited to take action and urge Members of Congress to enable the release and allocation of these funds.

URGE CONGRESS to Prioritize Science Funding

Over the past few months, Congressional appropriators have been drafting key legislation that will determine funding for federal science and statistical agencies for the next year, which were proposed to receive massive budget and staffing cuts

in the Presidential Budget Request. While Congress is likely to pass another year-long continuing resolution (CR), it is essential that our community fights for federal science funding and the scientific workforce. Write to your Members of Congress urging their support for research funding and to end the political interference into the federal scientific enterprise.

We encourage you to tailor the letter to your priorities. As a reminder, here are the Administration's proposed budget cuts for these agencies:

- A 56% cut to the National Science Foundation, including the dismantling of NSF's STEM education training and research programs.
- A 67% cut to the Institute of Education Sciences within the Department of Education.
- A zeroing out of the Department of Education's International Education and Foreign Language Studies programs, known as Title VI and Fulbright-Hays.
